## **Student Veteran of the Year**

The Student Veteran of the Year award is presented annually by the Veterans Support Center to a University of Utah student veteran in recognition of academic, civilian, and military accomplishments. The awardee is selected by a committee of peers based on his/her academic achievement, service to the University or community, and military service. The honor consists of an engraved medallion presented at the annual Veterans Day commemoration and his/her name engraved on a plaque displayed in the Veterans Support Center. Nominations are accepted from peers, faculty, and staff. Nominations should clearly explain why the nominee's military, civilian, and academic accomplishments are deserving of this recognition.

Application Eligibility
Nominee must meet all of the criteria below:
The nominee is a student veteran as defined by the Veterans Support Center.
The nominee is currently enrolled full-time in good standing at the University of Utah.
The nominee has earned a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher at the University of Utah.
The nominee has earned a minimum of 30 credit hours at the University of Utah.
The nominee has not been convicted of a felony or dishonorably discharged.
The n <mark>ominee has contrib</mark> uted to the nation, community and/or University in a significant manner.
Application Criteria
For a nominee to be considered:
Complete and submit the official application. Unofficial application will not be accepted; however, the narrative for the recommendation may be typed separately, as noted below.
The recommendation should clearly explain why the nominee should be considered. The narrative of the recommendation should not exceed the allotted space provided on this form or,
if t <mark>yped</mark> separately, should not exceed three pages in a font no smaller than 11 pt.

Applications must be received prior to midnight, October 13, 2017.
